Recommendation: Partially consistent with the Niagara River Greenway Plan

Niagara Musky Association • The improvements to ADA accessibility and to increase or change the use of the Meadow Shelter from seasonal to year-round are consistent with the Greenway Plan.

Presbytery of Western New York Activities planned due to a general maintenance need or due to disrepair and neglect over time are not consistent with the Greenway Plan. NREC recommends that the Commission discuss the difference in proposal elements and whether maintenance elements are included in this proposal.
