Sierra Club, Niagara Group • The concept of this project appears consistent with the Niagara River Greenway Plan but the proposal is lacking in the level of detail needed to conduct a full evaluation. Greater details and a budget breakdown should be provided prior to funding consideration.

Western New York Land Conservancy • NREC recommends including more robust ecological components that could enhance ecosystem function. Specific recommendations include planting of beneficial emergent or riparian species within the pond or upland buffer areas; inclusion of pollinator habitats around the pond and trails; consultation with vegetation experts prior to removing plant "overgrowth" in the pond.
